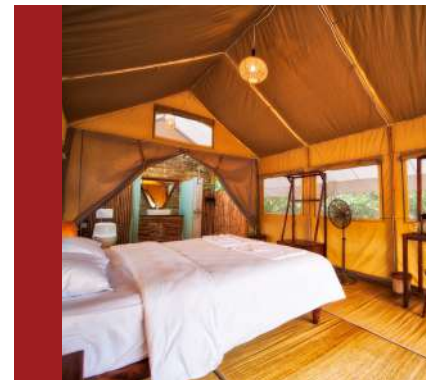
## Packages

### 3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS

### 4 DAYS 3 NIGHTS

This extended stay lets guests completely immerse themselves in the natural environment; special interest activities and overnight jungle stays can be scheduled to suit guest preferences, thus providing the highest educational value.
